- Own or contribute to materials that guide users or contributors through your engineering work: documentation, onboarding/migration, demos, blog posts, support questions, etc.
- Contribute to and advocate within relevant open source projects and organizations: SIGs, groups and projects in the ecosystem, etc.
- Educate GitOps and relevant projects to user communities (eg. Kubernetes, Helm, etc.) through writing, talks, demos, workshops, etc.
- Teach Weaveworks' open source technologies and commercial products to the community through talks, demos, writing.
- Listen to users for their challenges, use cases, and needs, and advocate for them by documenting and sharing the information.
- Assist with questions through online channels, and convert the answers into publishable content: blog posts, tutorials, talks, etc.
- Identify community champions, advocate for their needs, help them spread the word, and recognize their support.
